 Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes except Amateur Walking Derby and Amateur Walking Puppy  
 A blank cartridge will not be fired in the puppy stake.  
 Blank gun must not be capable of live ammo.  
 Shotguns with blank cartridges will not be permitted.
